
MITIGATING COVID-19 RISKS

OF DISINFECTANT PRODUCTS



Health Canada has designated specific disinfectant products – Health Canada's list of hard-surface disinfectants with evidence against COVID-19

STRICT LABEL ADHERENCE



The Health Canada product label defines the only conditions under which the product is **proven** to effectively kill viruses and bacteria.

CONFIRMED CONTACT TIMES



The minimum contact or "wet" time, specified on the product label, indicates how long a disinfectant product needs to sit wet on a surface in order to effectively kill viruses and bacteria.

COMMON QUESTIONS

Can I Disinfect Hard & Soft Surfaces with One Product?

Most disinfectant products are labeled for use on hard surfaces only. Sanitization and disinfection of soft surfaces, such as carpet and upholstery, requires specialized products and application methods defined by Health Canada.

Can a Space be Returned to Use Immediately After Disinfection?

In some cases yes. However, if the surface is a food contact surface, then additional rinsing and sanitizing will be required before returning to service.
